The Police Q&A Forum was held on November 15th at The Landing Clubhouse. The speakers (pictured left to right, below) included:

The Forum was a follow-up to our National Night Out in October to discuss many questions that we had concerning crime prevention in our neighborhood, such as:

- New open-carry gun law
- · Car and boat break-ins
- Filing crime reports & calling 911
- Scams
- "No Soliciting" signs on our houses
- Surveillance cameras with LPR capability, etc.

The speakers did a good job of addressing the list of questions we had for them and providing other helpful tips. One helpful tip was to lock doors that open from the garage into the house where break-ins and thefts often occur, even when the resident is home or nearby.

We in The Landing HOA appreciate all that the police do for us and want to support them any way we can. We are also very thankful for the speakers coming to our meeting and sharing information that helps our neighborhood and marina crime watch program and awareness.
